## **Character Descriptions:**

**Sister Aloysious:** The school principal, Sister Aloysius Beauvier, is in her fifties or sixties. She is watchful, traditional, and unsentimental. She has a stern devotion to duty, a belief in hierarchy and desire to protect. She has also loved, was loved and has a sense of humour.

**Sister James:** She is in her twenties, new to the school and finding her way. There's sunshine in her heart, though she's reserved. Ideologically, Sister James stands between Sister Aloysius and Father Flynn.

**Father Flynn:** A priest, Father Flynn, in his thirties. He is working class. He is warm with a desire to connect. He is relational and community oriented. He understands and acknowledges the way the Church operates; yet at times chooses to go his own way.

Mrs. Muller: Donald Muller's Mother. Mrs. Muller, a Black woman in her late 30s to 40s. She's on red alert and desires the best for her son.
