

SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Music on the Block Parking Lot Concert

If you plan to reserve a spot for the Turpin's Trail concert in the Firehall Parking Lot on September 18 2020, please read the following guidelines and protocols for your safety.

- There will be 'spots' for 4 persons (6ft apart) on the pavement in the parking lot, as designated areas for people to sit and be able to remain in their social bubbles.
- We can accommodate a maximum of 4 people per spot. A space for your group can be reserved online at 1000islandsplayhouse.com or by calling and leaving a message for our Box Office Coordinator, Sarah at 613-382-7086 ext. 33.
- On booking a spot you will be asked for your email and phone number. This is for contact tracing purposes.
- Masks must be worn on entrance to the gates of the Firehall Theatre parking lot. A portion of South St. will be closed. The entrance to the parking lot will be on the west side of the lot (closure to the Stone and South condo development).
- Masks can be removed only once you have reached your spot.
- Once you have entered, no one will be permitted to travel between spots.
- Hand Sanitizer will be available at all entrances and exits.
- There will be one outdoor washroom facility on site.
- You will be required to bring your own chairs. Beverages and snacks are permitted (no alcohol).

We are putting these guidelines in place for the health, safety and comfort of all those in attendance. If you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 or are not interested in following these guidelines, we ask that you please stay home.
