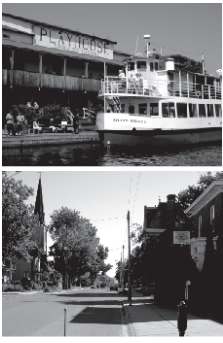
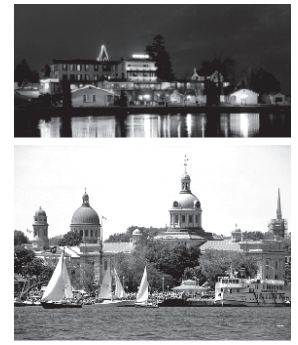


Sample Itineraries *Lots to see and do...*



Kingston and Gananoque are ideal travel destinations for those who enjoy sightseeing, spending time on the water, great food, entertainment and specialty shopping. These historic Eastern Ontario towns are full of beautiful architecture and walking trails. Whether you are looking for something entertaining, educational, or both, you'll find them within a few steps.

Here are two sample itineraries for your group, which show the possibilities that this region offers.



CANNONS, CRUISES AND COMEDIES A DAY IN KINGSTON

- 9:30am** – Tour the spectacular historic site of FORT HENRY, a marvellous reproduction of 19th century military life. The site offers guided tours, scenic views, and military demonstrations by the Fort Henry Guard.
- 12:00pm** – Enjoy a garden patio lunch at CHEZ PIGGY, gourmet soups and sandwiches on renowned PAN CHANCHO bakery bread.
- 1:30pm** – Hop aboard the CONFEDERATION TOUR TROLLEY and let the guides take you on a 50-minute visit through the historic sites and modern attractions of Canada's second-oldest city.
- 2:30pm** – Downtown Kingston offers some great SHOPPING!, whether at the Springer Square Antique Market or at any one of the local artist studios and shops.
- 5:00pm** – Freshen up and then board the 1000 ISLAND CRUISES for a dinner cruise aboard the Island Star. You'll travel through the Thousand Islands while enjoying a glass of wine and feasting on one of the chef's delicious entrees.
- 7:30pm** – The Island Star lands at the dock of "Canada's most charming theatre", the THOUSAND ISLANDS PLAYHOUSE. Enjoy an evening of professional theatre in a comfortable, air conditioned theatre overlooking the majestic St. Lawrence River.

- 1:00pm** – Relax with an after-lunch tea and sweets while listening to a WEDNESDAYS ON THE DECK pre-show chat by one of the theatre's creative crew. A great opportunity to mix and mingle with some of the cast before they get their costumes on!
- 2:30pm** – With up to 5 matinees per week, the THOUSAND ISLANDS PLAYHOUSE has many options for your group booking. And be sure not to miss the view at intermission that the Toronto Star calls "worth half the price of admission."
- 5:00pm** – It's time for a sizzling steak dinner at local fine-dining spot, MACNEIL'S LANDING. Owned by former Bells singer, Cliff Edwards who never misses the chance to serenade an unsuspecting customer.
- 7:00pm** – Try your luck at the roulette table, blackjack, or the slots at the THOUSAND ISLANDS OLG CASINO. Clean and air conditioned, this brand new gambling spot has become a hub of activity as the sun sets in the Islands!
